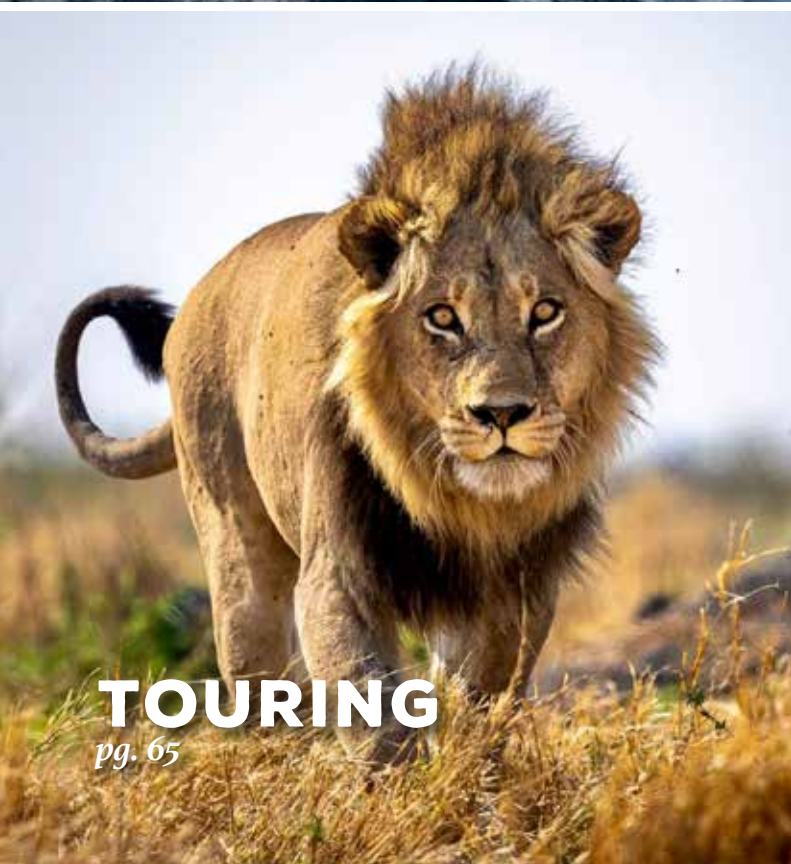

From meticulous management of our first-of-its-kind dove sanctuary to shell procurement in a very challenging ammunition market, 2024 is shaping up to be a banner season for our Cordoba clients.

Sanctuary and crop management ensures a relentless flow of birds, and despite the ongoing gun powder shortage, we have secured enough shells in every gauge to keep guns blazing for the 2024 season.

Owing to the vision, values and family culture of Trek's Cordoba partners, H&H Outfitters, you are always treated as honored guests at Guayascate. Once you return home, you'll have a hard time deciding whether the experience of Guayascate, or the astonishing dove numbers, were the most memorable part of your adventure.

It is estimated that there are over 20 million eared dove in the Cordoba Province. You'll likely never encounter so many birds in a single moment, hour or day than what you will see here in the Piquillin trees where the eared dove roosts.

Due to the region's rich agricultural environment and the lack of natural predators for doves, hunters are welcomed

by the Cordoba community for their positive impact on crop protection.

Guayascate offers its guests all the amenities of a five-star hotel, including a newly renovated spa and pool. These features are the primary reason Guayascate is one of Trek's most popular couples destinations.

We offer a three-day option for \$3,100 per hunter and a four-day option for \$4,095 per person. Prices include hunting, food, double occupancy lodging, license, gun rental and ground transfers.

A \$1,500 non-refundable deposit is required to confirm your reservation.





La Portenita Lodge

High-Volume Dove

First time hunters visit Cordoba to experience the mecca of high-volume dove hunting and to shoot a pile of shells you need a stepladder to see over. Those lucky enough to stay at La Portenita during their first visit often return frequently, as much for the accommodations as the hunting.

La Portenita is the product of brothers Alex and Zeke Hayes' vision to provide their guests with the absolute finest hunting experience in all of South America. This breathtaking working estancia was acquired by the Hayes brothers in 1995 and has been consistently upgraded to meet the high expectations of the modern hunter.

Each hunting day at La Portenita, your bird boy will meet you in the pre-scouted field with plenty of shells and a cooler of cold drinks. Shooting should be consistently strong until lunchtime.

Your field lunch will consist of local cuts of beef, chicken and pork, accompanied by excellent salads, fresh bread and fine wines. After lunch, you will continue to shoot until late afternoon until the sun starts to set, beckoning your return to the lodge for cocktails and appetizers, followed by a full dinner and wines.

La Portenita features six large bedrooms in the main house, as well as a separate villa with three additional bedrooms. The

lodge's recessed fire pit just outside the front door is popular for groups enjoying cocktails and conversation.

To reach Cordoba, you will connect through Buenos Aires, where you'll take a flight into Cordoba from either the international airport (Ezeiza) or the domestic airport (Aeroparque), depending on when you arrive to B.A.. Trek's most popular hunting programs are three hunting days at \$2,195/hunter

and a four hunting day option at \$2,795 per hunter to include shooting with lodging, meals, select wines, hunting license, gun rental, and transfers. Airfare, shells and gratuities, are not included.

We also offer a junior hunter special rate of \$1,500 for anyone 21 and under accompanying an adult paying the standard rate. A \$1,500 non-refundable deposit is required to secure spots.





Escondido Lodge

Pigeon & Dove

Escondido Lodge was opened in 2019, immediately delivering the sky-high standards of accommodation and service clients have come to expect from Trek's partners at H&H Outfitters. With charter flight service to Escondido from Cordoba now included in this package, you'll arrive to the lodge in style and ready to experience the best pigeon and dove action Argentina has to offer.

Escondido Lodge is a result of Trek's and H&H's ongoing commitment to innovations that optimize our wingshooting clients' experience. Located just beyond the Sierras de Cordoba, Escondido is situated within thousands of acres of land dotted with irrigation pivots watering fields of peanuts, soybeans and corn. March through July, these crops offer an expansive food source for migrating pigeon and resident eared dove.

Pigeon hunting here is an excitement-filled experience; you'll shoot from blinds as large birds drop down onto decoys set up by your bird boy. The dove hunting is a typical Cordoba high-volume, no limit experience. Our bird boys will keep your guns loaded for action all day.

Driving distance to the fields ranges from 15 to 50 minutes in our luxury nine-passenger vans with air conditioning, refreshments and two-way radios. Each client shoots with an experienced

professional bird boy, who will provide shells, act as a loader, retrieve downed birds and keep cool drinks ready. Shooting continues until noon, when the group gathers in a shady grove of trees for a traditional Argentine asado (barbecue).

Lunch may also be taken at the lodge, where you can enjoy a siesta in your air conditioned bedroom. The afternoon shoot continues until around 6 p.m. Shooters are welcomed back at the lodge with appetizers and a refreshing towel.

Routes connecting through Buenos Aires to Cordoba are operated on a daily basis. From there, you'll be met by a member of Escondido's team and shuttled to H&H's Cessna Grand Caravan for the short flight to Escondido.

Trips start at \$4,095/hunter, based on a minimum of four hunters, include four day's hunting, lodging, meals, drinks, select wine/liquor, license and permits and round trip private charter from Cordoba City. A \$1,500/hunter non-refundable deposit is required.



El Raigon

Trek is excited to introduce you to Argentina's newest mixed bag lodge, developed by our longtime partner outfitter Ariel Semenov and opening in 2023. Located among 4,000 pristine acres of diverse habitat, El Raigon delivers you the opportunity to shoot ducks, dove, pigeon and perdiz all within a short drive of the lodge.

We are able to offer exclusive use of El Raigon to groups of just six shooters. With a private landing strip near the lodge, those wishing to charter from B.A. will be able to save considerable travel

time to reach the lodge.

The newly renovated lodge comprises eight impressive single rooms, four of which are in the main house, with private bathrooms. Another guest house adjacent to the main house offers four additional rooms with two bathrooms to share. El Raigon's swimming pool is steps

away from the lodge, with a spa under construction for completion in 2023.

The beauty of El Raigon is you do not lose hunting days by traveling around Argentina searching for each species. While other mixed bag outfitters use several different lodges all hours apart, El Raigon gives hunters the ability to shoot four feathers all out of the same lodge.

To reach El Raigon, you'll take an overnight flight from the U.S., landing in Buenos Aires the following morning. From B.A., you'll have a domestic flight to the city of Santa Fe, followed by a comfortable transfer to the lodge. Trek partner representatives are always close by to assist with your transfers.

This is where the adventure truly starts, as you'll have three full and two half days of hunting ahead of you. The cost of this adventure is \$5,050 per hunter, based on a group of four, including guided hunting, meals, lodging, hunting license and transfers. A \$2,500 non-refundable per person deposit is required to secure space.

Cortaderas offers one of the most seasoned guide teams in Argentina, an essential element of any successful hunting operation offering the opportunity to target four feathered species in as many days. These guys love making new friends, and they work hard to make sure you enjoy unforgettable hunts.

If you're interested in marking the majestic Golden Dorado off your Treklist, the October-March time frame is optimal. Cortaderas is situated on the Parana River, one of the most productive Dorado rivers in the world.

Cortaderas offers 10 spacious single rooms with outdoor balconies, offering incredible sunset views of the river. Amenities include WiFi, satellite TV, a full bar and an outdoor fire pit.

Additionally, a full spa, including sauna, jacuzzi and massage therapists are at your

disposal. The lodge's professional chef will deliver the finest Argentine cuisine accompanied by excellent local wines.

Trek's recommended four hunting day program is \$5,050 per hunter. This price includes hunting (including one day of pigeons), unlimited fishing during your stay, five night's accommodations with meals, drinks, select wine, hunting license, and ground transfers related to the program.

A \$2,500 non-refundable per person deposit is required to secure space.

Providing an intimate, awe-inspiring setting and lodge exclusivity for groups of just six shooters, El Angel delivers the excitement of a new adventure each morning and afternoon you set out for the field.

Our local partners, Hector De Bernardis and his daughter Gina, have infused their immense passion for hunting and Argentinian culture into differentiating El Angel as a welcome place for all. Conveniently located just 2.5 hours from Buenos Aires, El Angel offers guests thrilling shooting opportunities for upland game (perdiz), waterfowl and

the sensational dove hunting for which Argentina is renowned.

El Angel's close proximity to Buenos Aires significantly reduces the travel time relative to that of most Argentinian mixed bag lodges. A Trek partner representative will meet you at the airport for the 2.5 hour transfer to the lodge. After lunch and a siesta, you'll be taking aim at clouds of doves or flushing perdiz your very first day in Argentina.

The following three days are full hunting days, with ducks in the morning, a break for lunch and doves or perdiz in the afternoon. On your final day in Argentina, you'll enjoy a morning duck hunt before packing up to head back to B.A. to catch your return flight to the U.S.

El Angel conveys a warm, authentic Argentinian feel that is representative of the rich legacy of the De Bernadis family. The lodge comprises eight impressive bedrooms with private ensuite baths. Other features include a swimming pool, a rustic bar, a spacious covered patio and a fire pit, all perfect spots for sipping cocktails and connecting with your fellow adventurers.

The most common way to reach El Angel is via an overnight flight from the United States, landing in Buenos Aires (B.A.) the following morning.

Price for the four-day hunt is \$4,995 per hunter, with a minimum of four shooters. Adventure price includes guided hunting, four night's accommodations with meals and drinks, gun rental hunting license and round trip transfer from B.A. To secure space, Trek requires a 50% non-refundable deposit.

South Pioneers founder Ramiro de las Carreras named this fantastic lodge Dos Plumas, which translates to "two feathers," because of the massive population of both doves and pigeons in the area.

The demand among Trek clients for consistent, high-volume pigeon shooting remains very strong. While we offer many excellent lodges that meet that demand, few also offer the level of hot-barreled dove shooting as that of Dos Plumas.

Throughout your adventure to San Luis, you will experience pigeons working decoy spreads, as well as pass shooting for those seeking an elevated challenge.

With space for up to ten hunters among five bedrooms, Dos Plumas sits close to the fields and offers a deluxe environment to relax after each day's shoot. The lodge employs a fully trained chef to provide traditional Argentine cuisine, paired with the finest wines in the region.

The best way to reach Dos Plumas is

a flight connecting in Santiago, Chile to Mendoza Argentina where South Pioneers will be on hand to transfer you 3.5 hours to the lodge.

We suggest at least four full days of shooting with five nights at the lodge, but we can certainly tailor the program

to include as many days as you wish.

The four-day hunt costs \$3,750 per hunter including the hunting, lodging, meals, and lodge transfers.

To secure space, Trek requires a 50% non-refundable deposit.



Inti Malal Lodge

Owner/Outfitters Gustavo Olsen and daughter Melissa continue their legacy of success at their highly revered Inti Malal Lodge near the city of Tucuman in Northern Argentina. Few places in Argentina can match the available dove population on display in this unique area.

Inti Malal sits on 225 acres and houses 14,000 square feet of comfort, offering eight bedrooms with private baths. A spacious and elegant common living and dining space, with a fully stocked bar, extends into the outdoor gallery with a barbecue pit, where guest can socialize and relax with their favorite drink.

Sooth tired muscles by spending time in the indoor spa area with a jacuzzi, massage section and sauna. Chef Javier Paineofilu

delivers delicious traditional meals and chef's specialties to the delight of all. Dove hunting in Tucuman is a little different than in other areas of Argentina.

You are up early and out to the field for a three-to-four-hour hunt over sorghum and sunflower fields before returning back to the lodge for lunch and siesta. Afternoon shoots are typically over water holes and roosting areas where the dove is heavily concentrated offering quick and challenging hunts.

The afternoon waterhole hunts are a

sight to behold, with thousands of doves circling small potholes or lagoons.

A typical hunting package to Inti Malal includes four days hunting with four nights lodging. To reach Tucuman you'll fly into Buenos Aires followed by a morning connection to Tucuman from Aeroparque.

This adventure is \$3,850 per hunter for four hunting days, single-room accommodations, meals and wines. A \$1,500 non-refundable deposit is required to secure space.





La Oriental

*Traditional
Decoying Duck Shooting*

An the heart of the rolling plains and fertile soil of Argentine Pampas, Estancia La Oriental is the very definition of a hidden gem. We are offering a hybrid program allowing each hunter either 60 ducks per day or eight boxes (which ever is reached first).

Much of Trek's long-standing Argentina waterfowl success can be attributed to Cano St. Antonin and his Four Seasons Adventures. For more than 20 years now, Cano has hosted Trek clients seeking to shoot decoying ducks in the finest habitat.

This region is a retreat for ducks with many acres providing ponds and lagoons created after the flood of Buenos Aires in 1988. These areas have progressed into a newly formed ecosystem perfect for the winter-feeding grounds of ducks.

You will find many species like common fulvous tree ducks, black bellied tree

ducks, white-faced tree ducks, southern widgeon, brown or Chilean pintail, white-cheeked pintail, speckled teal, cinnamon teal, Argentina red shoveler, silver teal, rosy billed pochard, black headed duck, and the lake duck.

Each morning you will rise to a full breakfast and head out with your guide hunting decoying ducks with opportunities to shoot 11 different species of ducks. Blinds are built with every hunter in mind using hard bottom construction, raised platforms, or "bucket" style pits. Well-trained Labradors will fetch each bird you take decoying into the spread.

After your morning hunt concludes,

you transfer back to La Oriental Lodge to enjoy appetizers, a full lunch and time to recharge. Around 3 p.m., you will head back out for your afternoon hunting lasting until dark or when you reach your limit of ducks. Each evening you will enjoy scrumptious Argentine meals and normally an early night as each morning comes quickly.

With a history that spans more than a century, La Oriental offers five impressive en suite guest rooms, as well as common area living and dining rooms.

The four-day hunt fee is \$4,500 per hunter with a 50% non-refundable deposit required to reserve space.



La Bellaca Lodge

Pigeon, Perdiz & Dove



Both pigeon and perdiz typically rank very high on Trek clients' list of targeted species, yet few destinations can offer quality hunts for both. La Bellaca in Uruguay is one of the few.

Built in 2014 as a vacation home for his family, Luis Brown soon realized the opportunity that exists around La Bellaca for shooting decoying pigeons, perdiz behind pointers and even dove. With Luis' son Patrick at the helm,

Trek is happy to offer La Bellaca now as Uruguay's most deluxe mixed bag option for small groups of four or more.

Just north of the popular vacation city of Punta del Este is a part of Uruguay

that very few hunters know even exists. It is off the beaten path with pasture land offering prime perdiz habitat along with lush fields of Sorghum offering ample food for the pigeons and dove.

Your mornings are spent walking behind a Brittany as the fog lifts out of the valleys, while your afternoons are spent among a spread of decoys as a group of pigeons approach or enjoying high-volume dove.

La Bellaca offers guests seven large bedrooms with heated floors in the private bathrooms, large living area and a covered terrace. The lodge chef will prepare fresh fish, famous South American beef and game from the field.

Getting to Bellaca is easy, as you will arrive in Montevideo where River Plate Outfitters will greet you then transfer you about an hour to the lodge.

Trek's typical package is three nights lodging with two full and two half days of shooting, with all meals and beverages included. Price for this is \$3,870 per hunter with a 50% non-refundable deposit required to secure a date.





Estancia Santa Clara

Ducks, Dove, Pigeon & Perdiz

The first year of this exciting new program garnered rave reviews from Trek clients. Excellent game, the stunning beauty of the estate and the gracious hospitality of our host family were all among the program elements that earned high marks.

Our partnership with Estancia Santa Clara extends you the opportunity to shoot four winged species on a breathtaking, centuries old estate that hosts just a handful of shooters each year. There are 50,000 on-property acres offering ten different duck lagoons/ponds, three sanctuary lakes offering refuse for the ducks.

Dove/pigeon shooting is hosted on one of many feedlots and or roosts. The partridge shooting here at Santa Clara is the best in the country and their kennel of dogs are spot on.

At Santa Clara, the wild rural gaucho (cowboy) culture and the fascinating history of its stately castle and family blend to create a unique setting for a bespoke shooting and hunting experience on their property of 50,000 acres with access to another 50,000 on adjacent parcels.

Santa Clara features eight bedrooms individually decorated and each having a private bath. Each single room has its

own decor and ambience and the many different common rooms throughout the house tell a different story in a time when Uruguay was in its infancy.

To reach Estancia Santa Clara, you'll fly into Montevideo, Uruguay using United and Copa Airlines which are airline partners to Montevideo. Once you arrive to Montevideo, a fast track VIP service will meet you as soon as you get off the plane and whisk you straight through immigrations.

Once your bags have been collected they will escort you outside to your waiting van from Santa Clara who will transfer you 2 hours 15 minutes to the lodge.

This seven-day, six-night adventure is \$5,995 per hunter, including four days of mixed bag shooting, single room accommodations, meals and all beverages, ground transfers in country, and gun rental and permits. A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to secure space.

Despite its location in the heart of a major waterfowl flyway, there are extremely limited duck hunting opportunities in Paraguay. Fortunately for Trek, our new partnership with the De Bernadis family has opened up a sensational Paraguayan duck hunting opportunity for our clients.

The De Bernadis family legacy has been forged by 30 years of experience in the hunting service industry. Their latest venture, Parque Zanjita Lodge, not only delivers sensational duck and pigeon hunting, but the lodge's location along the Paraguayan River brings the added bonus of golden dorado fishing into play.

The lodge is located just 10 minutes away from the duck and pigeon blinds where

you'll shoot. With extremely generous limits of 50 to 60 ducks per day per hunter, Parque Zanjita promises some of the most productive waterfowl hunting you'll ever encounter.

The Villa Oliva region is home to various species of exotic ducks. Some common species you may encounter include the highly coveted Rosy-billed Pochard, whistling duck and Silver Teal.

You'll hunt around massive rice fields

where highly experienced guides will set blinds and array decoys. After a morning hunt and a hearty lunch, you'll have the opportunity to head back to the blinds or hop on a boat right by the lodge for some golden dorado action.

The lodge itself is quaint and rustic, recently upgraded with modern amenities. Its three comfortable rooms are double occupancy, providing you with exclusive use for just six shooters.

To reach Parque Zanjita, you'll take an overnight international flight to Silvio Pettirossi International Airport (ASU) in Asuncion. You'll be met by a Trek partner represented and be transferred around two hours to the lodge. You'll settle in and have lunch before heading out for an afternoon duck hunt.

Trip price is \$5,995 per hunter, including three full days and two half days of guided duck hunting, four night accommodations with meals, wine and drinks, gun rental, hunting license and round trip transfers between Asuncion and Parque Zanjita Lodge. A 50% non-refundable deposit is required to secure a date.

Trek Safaris and longtime outfitter Erik Von Sneidern have teamed up again in Paraguay to offer one of the best high-volume decoying pigeon opportunities in the world. During this adventure, you will enjoy three full hunting days and two half days for Columbus Picazueros and blue-gray spotted pigeons.

We mostly shoot over the recently harvested peanut fields that attract pigeons in massive numbers. The pigeons normally come in groups of 5-30, making this area heaven for anyone shooting doubles.

Typically, flock after flock of pigeons pour in all morning long, settle during mid-day when we recharge and take our lunch, and the action fires up again in the afternoon.

Most drives to the pigeon areas are within 45 minutes to one hour from the hotel. Your two attentive bird boys will build blinds, spread out decoys, including electronic “pigeon magnets” and keep you well refreshed.

The best way to reach Asuncion is United/Copa Airlines connecting in Panama City Panama either from MIA or IAH. Once you arrive in Asuncion, you will be met by our local agents and transferred to a charter flight to the hunt area.

Go off the grid for exceptional high-volume pigeon shooting.

Boqueron Hotel offers comfortable accommodation in Neu-Halbstadt, Paraguay. The property boasts 22 guest rooms, all elegantly decorated and equipped with modern amenities such as air conditioning, Wi-Fi and cable TV.

Facilities and services available to guests staying at the hotel include inclusive breakfast and an on-site restaurant serving

German and Paraguayan cuisine.

Ducks & Perdiz



Duck hunting returned to Uruguay last year after a three-year pause, and the action was exceptional. Trek invites you to once again experience one of South America's premier waterfowl regions. Uruguay is renowned by hunters for its impressive array of duck species such as Brazilian ducks, Rosy-Bill Pochards, and Brown Pintails. Heavy rains in 2023 have significantly boosted duck numbers.

Trek's roots go back many years in the Rocha Department of Uruguay mainly because it is one of the best duck hunting areas in South America. After a few years of allowing the waterfowl to rejuvenate, Trek has renewed its relationship in Chuy with outfitter Eduardo Gonzalez operating out of the newly renovated La Lagunita Lodge.

Daily limits are generous, with hunters allowed four boxes of shells each morning and four boxes each afternoon.

Your trip starts on with an overnight flight from the United States arriving Montevideo the following morning. Upon arrival in Montevideo, a member of Eduardo Gonzales' staff will meet you, assist you with clearing guns with customs and escort you four hours to the lodge.

Over the next three days, you'll enjoy duck hunts each morning and the choice

of either ducks or perdiz in the afternoon.

Each morning we will have a full breakfast at Lagunita around 4:45 AM, and then head out to the lagoons. In the Rocha area we hunt mostly fresh water lagoons and potholes, scouting them consistently.

Most of the time we will be hunting in double blinds with each blind having a sitting stake and a spread of decoys. Most all the ducks will decoy to the spread and depending on the time of year you hunt, we will be shooting a wide variety of ducks. Perdiz are hunted behind Eduardo's excellent kennel of Brittany's.

Uruguay's perdiz season runs from May until August, with a limit of ten perdiz per hunter. Groups traveling after August 1 will be shoot ducks morning and afternoon with a mid-day break at the lodge for lunch and siesta.

This trip is \$4,250/hunter and includes three full and one half days of hunting, permits and licenses, four nights accommodations with meals, wines, alcohol, and all transfers in Uruguay. A 50% non-refundable deposit is required.

lodge boasts the ultimate in luxury and amenities, including a full spa. Perhaps equally impressive to producing such a spectacular second lodge is that Jorge, his family and long time staff have managed to maintain the highest level of service and personal attention to every visitor they host. Jorge Jr., acquiring the entrepreneurial gene from his father, has built a full scale brewery just a five-minute walk from either lodge.

The prime shooting season in Bolivia is from April through October, with exceptional shooting from beginning to end. As seasons are reversed below the Equator, the July, August and September months are cooler in Bolivia, meaning that the birds will tend to fly most of the day, so this is an outstanding time

to visit. In addition to the high-volume dove shooting here, Jorge has added a morning pigeon shoot.

To get there, you'll fly into Santa Cruz and clear immigrations, procure your Bolivian Visa (if needed) and gather your bags. Our partners will be waiting just outside the terminal doors to greet you and escort you to the lodge.

The three shooting day trip at Las Palomas runs \$2,495 per shooter and the four day is \$3,195. The Prehistoric Behemoths of Bolivia's Amazon

Growing up to nine feet in length and tipping the scales at over 400 pounds in weight, Arapaima are among the largest, oldest and most unique freshwater fish on Earth. So, its no surprise they are a highly coveted bucket-list species in angling.

Arapaima's complex and fascinating biological structure is a key reason arapaima can be traced back to prehistoric ages.

An intricate corrugated system of mineralized scales and layers of collagen fibers allow arapaima to flex and deform in pursuit of prey and in evading threats, providing them with the protection of a tank and the agility of a fighter jet.

If you're looking to check this ancient, armor-plated behemoth off your list, you won't find a more target rich environment than Bolivia's Cano Negro Lodge (CNL). This past season, Trek hosted a group to CNL and our anglers landed arapaima in great numbers .

Arapaima are an invasive species to this region of the Amazon, the result of a fish farm that released the first

fish into the area. Cano Negro's arapaima population has exploded in recent years, owing to their suitability to the ecosystem and the river's abundance of aquatic prey. With both gills and a lung-like swim bladder, arapaima thrive in the river's slow-moving backwaters.

The seasoned guides at CNL know exactly where to find them, as their continuous surfacing for oxygen is a

conspicuous tell. An elite apex predator with a voracious appetite, arapaima take a variety of presentations, from large flies to cut bait.

In addition to arapaima, you can catch a stunning variety of exotic fish here, including peacock bass, payara, red-tailed catfish and surubi. You'll also

observe a fascinating array of wildlife, including jaguars, cayman and Bolivian red howler monkeys.

Many of our clients combine a few days of fishing at CNL with a dove shoot in Santa Cruz (see pg. 59). Truly, an epic cast-and-blast adventure you'll always remember.

all rods (TFO), reels (Shimano) and lures, providing a true fly in and fish experience.

The floating cabin configuration provides unmatched portability that allows us to continue to explore new waters and deliver clients deep into the hot spots. This experience is a safari on the water; you are literally in the bush, in close proximity to wildlife only found in the rainforests of Brazil, but with creature comforts like queen beds and air conditioning.

Each single cabin is equipped with a queen bed, a/c, and bathroom with shower, hot water and storage areas for your clothes and equipment. The air-conditioned dining cabin is the perfect post-fishing meet-up spot.

While you will be fishing in the jungles of the Amazon, groups arrive into Manaus, Brazil and stay overnight in order to make an early charter flight to camp the following morning.

Pacific Fins is an intimate resort with four two-bedroom villas. The lodge is constructed on an estuary with just a narrow spit of beach separating it from the Pacific. In the evenings while enjoying a cigar and rum by the pool, you can easily hear the waves crashing on the nearby shore.

The ocean currents that pull bait fish into the "bucket" just miles off the Guatemalan coast lure fish of every

variety into these waters. Runs in slick calm seas will run from 5 to 30 or more miles as sails do tend to move around.

No matter where they are, your local captain will get you there safely and in comfort aboard your 31-32' sportfishing boat. Although sails are the primary target here, you will also encounter large schools of dorado and a nice mix of tuna, skip jack and yellowfin. Marlin, though not here in big numbers, do show up on occasion, with Trek anglers in the past landing blues up to 700 pounds!

Guatemala City is serviced daily by most major carriers. Although our normal trip is for five day and four lodge nights with three full days of off shore action, if you feel up to the challenge, we can add as many days as you think you can handle.

The subtropical climate of these islands is temperate year round, regulated by the warm El Nino Current and the cold Humboldt Current, creating two distinct seasons. The warmest of these seasons is December-May when the sky is clear and the sun is shining most of the time.

If you wish to explore the amazing underwater world of the islands, the best time to visit Galapagos is June-November. During this season the weather provides you the best chance for up-close encounters with Galapagos famous marine wildlife.

This period, generally called the "dry season", brings blue skies and mid-day showers. During this season, you may

observe a large number of species around the islands, such as: giant tortoises, Humpback whales, blue footed boobies, cormorants, oystercatchers, lava lizards, Galapagos hawks, masked boobies, swallow tailed gulls, sea lions, lava herons, brown noddies, penguins, etc. Due to the water temperature it is the perfect time for diving, snorkeling and scuba diving.

The period between December and May is considered the "warm season", during

which the climate is more tropical with daily rain and cloudier skies. The ocean temperature is warmer for swimming. During this time, tourists may observe a large number of animal species, such as: marine iguanas, sea turtle, land iguanas, flamingos, white-cheeked pintails, masked boobies, marine iguanas, albatross, blue-footed boobies, etc.
